Re: Toe Stoppers

I have been using your Toe Stoppers Equestrian model and found them great. Recently I have been using the new Universal model of Toe stoppers, fantastic. My new horse is very green and jumps well clearing each obstacle with plenty of space.

I have found that having my feet well into the stirrups has helped keeping me still while he is learning. Riding in the Toe Stoppers has given me confidence to keep my foot hard into the stirrup and allowed me to ride more forward on a green horse.

I have had two falls, one from a buck and one from a large jump, both times my feet came out quickly and easily and I luckily landed on my feet with no damage. I don't plan on repeating this, but am pleased to say "They work".

Hunting is a passion of mine and the terrain is hilly, uneven ground with going wet and boggy. Toe Stoppers can also prevent a fall as the Toe Stopper pocket supports my foot preventing it slipping and helps maintain my balance when a horse becomes unpredictable or the going is rough.

Hunting is unpredictable and you never know where you may end up following the hounds, many of the spars are just one wire, or a small baton and you need to be riding forward and confidently, the Toe Stoppers allow me freedom with security in these conditions. I wouldn't ride without them now. Other than added security you would not notice that you are riding them, until you need them.
