Dear Adrian,

After using your Toe Stoppers for the past 4 weeks, and doing numerous events eg: Anzac Day march, 80km trail ride, eventing days and so on, All I can say is they are the best safety invention since the helmet I have had the pleasure of using.

With safety being my upmost concern with what I do, all I have been doing since I placed them on my stirrups is recommend them to everyone whom will listen. My 4yo son also uses them at pony club and his confidence has boosted that much he has gone from a Shetland pony only walking and a little trotting, to 14.3 horse walking, trotting and cantering with great ease and no feet coming out on stirrups.

On a more important note being a mounted paramedic for the Queensland Ambulance Service. I am asked to accompany riders on allot of trail rides, from 2Hrs in duration to 2 Days, with up to 500 riders and horses. As you can imagine there are an enormous amount of falls on these events, only a week ago I attended one of these and saw right in front of my eyes a competitor fall of in a gully then get dragged up a very steep hill due to her foot getting stuck in her stirrup, therefor I had to treat her and send her back to camp and then to Hospital for x-rays and further treatment. These injuries could have been very easily prevented with the use of the Toe Stopper.

In conclusion being a competitive rider myself I have found that the Toe Stopper is not only a fantastic safety product but also has some other benefits, they keep your feet in the correct riding position at all times and make it extremely comfortable, as most horse riders would know or have sustained back soreness or injury in their riding career, well I had a bad fall when I was a professional jockey, now I suffer from regular numbness in my right leg and foot I have to dismount and walk my horse until I get full feeling and movement back in my foot, but after an 8hour trail ride and not having to dismount once it has made it a pleasure to ride again.

I have and will continue to recommend the Toe Stopper to all disciplines of the Equestrian community. I truly believe that this is the best safety product I have ever seen and used in my 22years of riding thank you for allowing my family and myself the safety they deserve.
