I am writing to you to tell you how delighted I am with Toe Stoppers.

As a qualified equestrian coach, I have students ranging in age from 7 through to adult riders.

For my beginner riders I have found that the Toe Stoppers provide the safety required to prevent their foot from slipping through the stirrup iron and becoming firmly lodged in a position that could become extremely dangerous.

This then allows the rider to be able to concentrate on the many other aspects of their position, without having to worry about their foot position.

One of my younger students has had a problem with keeping her heels in the correct position. After I put her in the Toe Stoppers, her comment to me was that how much more balanced she felt in the saddle because of the fact that she could keep her heels down and she was no longer tipping forward.


After 6 weeks of using the toe Stoppers, we have removed them, and have found that she is now able to keep her heels down without having to think about it.

It has also allowed riders who are not sure that Horse Riding is what they want to do, to experience the fun and pleasure it can provide without the expense of having to buy correct riding boots for what might be a one off ride.

The other advantage of them, is that they are such low maintenance – with the busy lifestyle that we have with the horses, this is a bonus.

I would highly recommend them to anyone who is interested in trying them for use in equestrian past times.
