I have been using Toe Stoppers in races for the last month where possible and found them to be comfortable.

The pocket support gives me more balance and stops your feet from moving around in the irons. They are soft and durable and easy to put onto your iron.

There are many incidents where riders are being hooked up and dragged and I believe that the Toe Stoppers are a beneficial safety device as to reduce these incidents both at trackwork and raceday.

Unfortunately I can only use them on limited rides, to be able to use them all the time there would need to be a weight allowance for them. I believe that if a weight allowance was introduced that many jockeys would use them.
