Dear Adrian,

Having recently taken my two boys (aged 13 & 16) riding on a friend's property I had the opportunity to trial Toe Stoppers. The three of us noticed a great difference in the feeling of "security" that the product provided and as far as the boys were concerned who are novice riders they achieved a far greater degree of balance and thus were riding in a more correct position.

In the past I have had a great fear of them coming off and getting caught up having seen in it happen several times many years ago when I was instructing at a Sydney riding school.

I very strongly feel that the product should be mandatory for all commercial riding organisations as it will lead to much improved safety, novice riders will gain confidence and I imagine from a business point of view that insurance companies would look favourably on its usage leading to a reduction in premiums.

It seems to me to be a "no brainer" as far as the racing industry is concerned. It will inevitably save lives and probably has already done so. A small weight allowance given across the board would seem like a very trivial issue to stand in the way of jockey's safety.
