I thought you my like an update on the success of the "Toe Stoppers" at Epsom R.D.A. Riding for The Disabled.

We have found them an excellent product.

Not only do they provide a very good safety aid, but also ensure that the riders balance is improved, a great asset when the rider is disabled either by disease or accident.

Everybody finds them very easy to fit and consequently they get used everyday. Not only are they a great safety asset, we all know that the Health & Safety is paramount and Toe Stoppers prevent the riders feet going through the stirrup.

Many of our riders do not have adequate shoes / boots with heels and because we are one of the few R.D.A's that operate everyday we cannot provide them, we average about 100 rides a week, however we have overcome this problem with Toe Stoppers.

They place the rider's feet in correct position in the stirrups, this then aids the rider in being able to have better balance, an essential part of riding.

Riding is one of the few aspects that some of our children / adults will ever be able to take part in, so it is essential that they do it with safety, comfort and confidence, while giving them a sense of achievement and independence. Toe stoppers aid us to do this with the minimum amount of fuss.

They are easy to attach to the stirrups and because they are molded rubber they do not lose their shape.

I have no hesitation in recommending Toe Stoppers to anyone.
